In the Ocean of Night, by Gregory Benford, reviewed by Garry Dalrymple

In "In the Ocean of Night" The main character deals with the death / eternal life of a partner and a career length involvement with SETI. First as a working Astronaut, he encounters an extinct giant alien space ship that has to be destroyed to prevent it falling to earth and secondly as a manager of the team charged with communicating with an alien probe. The probe is the emissary of the machine intelligences of the universe who take an interest in observing the rise of flesh and blood intelligences.

There is a sub plot involving "bigfoot" and the difficulty of exploring part of an alien spacecraft crashed for millions of years ago on the Moon. The main thread however is an ongoing story of working Science having to live with those who feel that Science should only advance in service to "higher" theocratic / cultic beliefs.

Not Benford's best work, possibly a response to the Reagan years?

Night Watch, by Sergei Lukyanenko, review by Charina

For centuries the forces of Light and Dark have fought for humanity's souls, neither side gaining a definitive advantage over the other. Finally an uneasy truce was called. The terms? Each side could only influence humanity to the same extent of the other side. If an agent of Light used their power to convince someone to do good, Dark would then be entitled to push someone into doing evil. No good deed goes unpunished.

The Night Watch works between sunset and sunrise, and ensures that the agents of the Dark are keeping to the truce. Andre is an agent of the Night Watch. While some of his fellow agents are shape-shifters and sorcerers, Andre only has mediocre powers. For the past few years he has been working at the Russian arm of the Night Watch as their IT System Manager, a role he was content with. Things begin to change when "the boss" decides Andre needs more field work experience. Slowly Andre starts to learn that he is merely a pawn in a centuries old battle, but his movements are some of the most strategically important on the game board.

The three stories in this novel have been translated from the original Russian. Perhaps because of this, the writing is simple and straightforward. However this suits the atmosphere of the book, and accentuates the bleak city setting. The story line was different from what I expected. Having only seen the previews for the movie, I expected it to be a vampire slasher novel. While vampires do play a part, the main story is more politically based. The Light and Dark have a delicate balance, but both sides are still trying to manoeuvre around the treaty to gain victory. Since they can't blatantly influence events, without giving an advantage to the other side, they must manipulate situations so that the other side is misled about their activities. Andre is used indiscriminately by both the Light and the Dark to push forward their interests. At times this can make Andre seem a bit of a dupe. But the stories are engrossing, and make a thoroughly enjoyable read.

Sequel to Those Who Walk in Darkness

This is a cracking police procedural novel a follow up the 2003 novel. It is set in a world of tomorrow but not our tomorrow. It is a world of superpowered thugs and law-breakers, post The Age of Super-Heroes, as they have all been made illegal (at least in the USA). Comic book readers will be reminded of Powers by Brian Bendis.

Can ordinary human policemen & policewomen take on mutants and freaks, with abilities far beyond those of normal mortals? If normal guns cannot break their skin, what can they fight with? (A major plot line).

The two heroines, Soledad and Eddie, belong to the LAPD and are well-drawn & believable characters, fighting mutants, monsters and corruption and ethnic prejudice within their own ranks. (Very believable for anybody with a knowledge of that famous police force).

It contains a huge twist in this sequel - which I will not disclose. I didn't see that coming!

Gardens of the Moon by Steven Erikson, reviewed by Stuart Wark

Steven Erikson (a pseudonym for Steve Lundin) is a Canadian author who has worked as an archaeologist and anthropologist in both North America and the United Kingdom. Erikson has now written six of a predicted ten novels in the epic fantasy Malazan Book of the Fallen sequence. Gardens of the Moon is the first volume in the series.

Gardens of the Moon is epic in all aspects of the word. As befitting the starting point for a series projected for ten books, the plot is very intricate and complicated. It concerns an ongoing war between the Malazan empire ruled by Empress Laseen, and Anomander Rake and the Tiste Andi, a group of warrior mages. The Empress is portrayed as unlovable tyrant, and the empire has an internal battle as well, with some soldiers more loyal to their direct commanders than the actual Empress. It is almost impossible to capture the plot successfully in a few sentences, but in addition to the human battles, the role of the Gods and their manipulation of the world adds to the intrigue.

Erikson has turned many of the conventions of fantasy writing on its head. Gardens of the Moon is not an easy read, with a multitude of characters and settings to keep track of. The book seems to commence mid-story, and almost infers that the reader should have some level of prior knowledge. As a literacy device it is interesting, as the reader feels that they are joining a real situation, rather than starting a story that has no pre-history. However, it is therefore also quite difficult to work out what is happening at times. There are also sections that are quite disjointed and need to be re-read a few times to understand what is occurring. The level of detail is one of the hallmarks of the novel, however, the sheer complexity could also be considered the book's greatest drawback.

Erikson has managed to create a cast of highly complex individuals that are not often evident within the fantasy genre. His training as an anthropologist has undoubtedly assisted him in the development of the characters. They all appear to have real personalities, honest emotions and understandable motivations. The world is highly developed and involved, but to put in bluntly, it is almost too elaborate.

Gardens of the Moon outlines an amazingly thought out world and storyline. Its design and potential is almost staggering, but it isn't all laid out easily. It is highly recommended for all fans of epic fantasy series, but be warned that it does take some time and effort from the reader.

Blaze of Glory by Michael Pryor, reviewed by Janelle

Blaze of Glory is the first book of several in the Laws of Magic which is set in an early 20th century alternate England where magic is as "real" as physics. Aubrey Fitzwilliam, the son of a prominent politician, is brilliant at magic (and scheming), and feels he must live up to his father's achievements. He manages to overextend himself into a little bit of a predicament, which is where the book begins. Although Aubrey is at school, he's in his final year, and he doesn't really come across as a schoolboy, possibly because with the exception of the opening and closing chapters, we see very little of him at school. Aubrey and his best friend George Doyle (Watson to Aubrey's Holmes) manage to foil several seemingly politically motivated plots through the book, finally unmasking the villain. There are several twists in the plotting, making it not entirely obvious as to the villain's identity and motivations. Some issues are left to be resolved in the next book in the series, but there's no cliffhanger ending here; the story is pretty much complete in itself.

I enjoyed it quite a bit, although I did want to smack Our Hero sometimes for being a bit too excellent at everything.
