***Runemarks* by Joanne Harris, reviewed by Hayden**

Runemarks is set in a world loosely based on Norse mythology. Ragnarok has come and gone 500 hundred years earlier. The world has moved on and the gods are no longer revered as once they were. A young girl, Maddy grows up in a small village dominated by the Order, a quasi-religious group that has arisen since the time of Ragnarok. She has been born with a rune on her arm, a sign of the old gods, and as a result is an outcast amongst her own people. She has no friends in the village... in fact, there is only one person that she considers to be a friend, the Outlander simply known as One-Eye. One-Eye is a stranger to the village, a wanderer who travels around the world. He has taught Maddy the old, forbidden knowledge... runes, cantrips, glamours and enchantments. However, now One-Eye wants Maddy to open the gate upon Red Horse Hill and to descend to the World Below. If she doesn't... it could be the end of all she knows.

The book is targeted towards younger readers and it follows a basic and well worn pattern in fantasy. A young child, unaware of their destiny... a mysterious old person who turns out to be much more than they first seem to be... a world on the brink of destruction. The story flows along smoothly, the book is an easy read and as such it is not hard to follow the events as they occur.

However, having said all of that, I did enjoy reading this book. It was an enjoyable break from the usual convoluted plotlines that are found in the multi-book series that dominate fantasy nowadays. Also, as it is a standard alone novel and not part of a series, it makes for a nice change not to have to wait for years to be able to reach the end of the story.

***The Man With the Golden Torc* by Simon R Green, reviewed by Greame**

This book centres around a character who uses with the pseudonym Shaman Bond. From the outset it tries to be a parody of the James Bond character set in a world where daemons, elves, witches and worse secretly influence our modern world. Shamans job is to secretly protect humankind and eliminate these nasties. This much is much is given away by the back cover.

The book is fast paced and the dialogue is extremely entertaining. The characters can tend to be a bit over the top, with some the powers these characters possess, and the damage they do making the whole concept of secrecy very implausible. It is a light entertaining read that is fast paced full of magical gadgets, characters that tend to be one dimensional and a plot line interwoven with both humor and predictability.

The style that Green has used here is different that his Deathstalker series It is lighter with more magic and humor and it takes itself far less seriously.

So as long as you don't expect too much of this book and are looking for some escapism, this book is worth the portion of you life that you lose reading it.

***The Company of the Dead* by David Kowalski, reviewed by Tim**

This is a time travel thriller with science fiction elements. It is firstly a suspense mystery with secrets and cold war espionage, and a conspiracy of staggering ambition, but at the core of the story is time travel. Most of the story is set in an alternate near future earth, of similar technical level to ours but with refreshingly different science applications. I was a little perplexed that an Australian writer would set most of the story in America, even if an alternate America, not the USA. However, one could argue that the past 100 years or so has seen the rise of America and as this story shows, history could easily have been different. Kowalski has Germany still triumphant from the Great War and Japan its major rival. North America has suffered proxy wars and partitioning. The plot repeatedly revisits the sinking of the Titanic and follows the unfolding understanding of its significance to the protagonists. Some are subverted to be true believers, some go mad and some oppose because they cannot understand.

There are many characters and this can get confusing, but their ranks thin as the plot thickens. Once I was well inducted into Kowalski's world (say 100 pages) I was as hooked as I would be to a Matthew Reilly action adventure. This is of very different style, however, and reminded me of "Ash" by Mary Gentle, "The Scar" by China Meville and "Marrow" by Robert Reid. In his storytelling, he achieves where many new writers fail, he shows rather than tells. There is plenty of exposition, but it is in the action that we see the characters develop. His medical background shows in some of the language use, but appropriately as when we read from the perspective of a character who is a doctor. The story jumps often in perspective from character to character and has many short chapters. This reminded me of the flicker of old B&W newsreels, as it imparts a sense of history happening, with the flickering unknowability of historical fine details. After all, who knows what really happened on board the Titanic, and how the 20th century could have turned out, and what conspiracies are true.

A vampire love story filled with the angst and innocence of first love. 'New Moon' by Stephenie Meyer is the sequel to 'Twilight' and continues the tale of Isabella Swan's romance with Edward Cullen, her new friendship with Jacob, an old friend, and the choices she needs to make for her life to work. Edward happens to be a vampire; one of the good guys who feeds on animals, not people. Jacob is not quite what he seems either; the one thing he and Edward have in common is their love for Isabella. Dealing with high school, relationships and a quick trip to Italy to save her true love, Isabella's life is certainly anything but dull.

'New Moon' and 'Twilight' are both written for the teen market with the emotional extremes that characterise relationships during this age. If you enjoy LJ Smith's 'Vampire Diaries' and 'Nightworld' series, then these books are definitely worth picking up.

"If you could have taken 'serious action' you'd have done so by now, kiddo. But don't worry, I'll get what's coming to me. How much radiation are you emitting right now?" He diddled her circuits one-handed, slowly undermining her perfect tech-*qi* with data-blocks as sharp and fine as acupuncture needles. "In five years when I get leukaemia, I'll go out cursing your name and karma."

"I couldn't be nuclear." She was offended by the suggestion. Singh guessed the last time someone had switched her on had been when the power stations in Mumbai started combusting. Maybe the fall-out had reached as far as Diacon by then; she would have seen pieces of the city raining down around her, dust and ashes that glowed like false stars at night. "I'm responsible for... for *lives*."

Lives. There was a familiar tinge of despair in her voice. Singh had heard it from other sprites he'd woken. There was always that moment when they realised that they'd failed, that their systems had been destroyed by a combination of quakes, pulses and the apocalyptic Mumbai nuke-plosion. That the people they'd been protecting had died. That their reason for existing was gone.

Most of them decommissioned themselves after that, flicking whatever internal *off* switch they used to commit electronic suicide. Singh had hopes for this one though—the more indignant a sprite was, the more likely it'd stick around. "What did Diacon do? Medical?" he asked.

"Cryogenic." The sprite started to pace—he heard the tinny, fake sound of her audio simulating foot falls.

"I suppose they're all *really* dead now." She laughed unexpectedly. "Not that anyone would want to come back to life in this burnt out old world."

Singh sighed. His old sprite, Millie, had been a pleasant kid, too polite to talk about human mortality, who sang when he was feeling down. She'd come from a children's hospital in Beijing; being *nice* was part of her core module. Evidently the Diacon sprite's programmers had no such construction requirements. "We get by," he muttered.

The sprite snickered. "Barely. Look at you, dressed in rags, breaking into a broken-down cryogenics factory to survive... Wait. What on earth do you need from me anyway?"

"My truck's broke. Need spare parts."

"Your *truck*?" Now she was really offended. "I may have been officially out of order for over a decade, but I'm still a multi-million dollar corporate sprite with a 98% perfect artificial intelligence. I co-ordinated one of the largest cryogenic networks in the world. They wrote an article about me in *Time* magazine. And you want to steal bits of me to stick in your stupid truck?"

"It's not a stupid truck." With the last data-block squeezed snugly into place, Singh plugged in a hard drive and started the file-shift. He crawled out from underneath the console to find the sprite glaring down at him. Up close she was visibly translucent. He could see dusty health and safety signs behind her, slightly distorted like objects viewed through a balloon. "It's a clever automated truck—or it used to be, before some punks with a pulse-gun fried out Millie. I needed a new sprite fast and Diacon was on my way."

"Wait. You're stealing *me*? For your car..." The sprite looked thoughtful. "Like... in *Nightrider*?"

"With you, kid? More like *Christine*."

She pouted, then blinked out of vision for a second as the file shift finished, and reappeared four metres away looking out of focus and two dimensional. Sprite in a travel bag, Singh thought, scooping up the hard drive.
