

This is book two of the "Godspeaker" series. It is the story Rhian and her battles to claim her inheritance and become queen of Ethrea. Book one, which I also reviewed, I found very bloody and cruel and at times quite evil, but it is important to read book one, *Empress of Mijik*, first. Of course these two books are connected but that connection does not become apparent until well into the story.

I really, REALLY, enjoyed the *Riven Kingdom*. It is not as bloody, gory and cruel as book one. Princess Rhian is a loveable and kind girl, and with her chief off-siders, Jones, Ursa and Zandaka adventure ensues. This book at times makes an exciting and very tense read.

Once again Karen Miller has written a well constructed story. She has the ability to pull you right into the story as if one were really present and part of the story. Congratulations Karen, readers will enjoy this series.

Airman by **Eoin Colfer**, reviewed by **Liam**

Airman is set at the end of the 1800's (1878 - 1894) in the period of when the race for flight was a joke (for the public) and a great scientific discovery era (for the knowledgeable population). The author, Eoin Colfer has taken the idea of the Saltee islands which he saw as a kid and turned them into a diamond mining, monarchy based, little kingdom with a few little eccentrics mixed in for fun.

The story-line goes as follows: boy born in balloon, boy meets princess, boy saves princess's life, boy embarrasses himself in front of princess, boy discovers great treachery, boy gets blamed (and deceived), boy gets sent to really, really bad diamond mining prison, boy makes flying designs, boy escapes in balloon, boy gets rich, boy discovers murder plan, boy saves the day and get princess while he's at it. A simple story, really.

The story line is similar to a medieval adventure story, but in the time of discovery with normal Eoin surprises. The hero, Conor, faces great treachery and finally defeats the villain. The storyline also has a slight romance side to it. The story goes quickly at the beginning, then slower and then speeding up near the end.

The book is quite obviously a single novel with not many follow-up leads that could lead to a sequel, though there are a few loose ends but they are mostly small ones. I have read many other books by Eoin Colfer and this book is similar in style to the *Supernaturalist*. It is suitable for young adult readers.

Eoin Colfer was born in Ireland in 1965 and lives there now with his wife and two children. His first book "Benny and Omar" was published in 1998. He was able to write fulltime after the success of the first *Artemis Fowl* book in 2001. *Airman* was released for publication in February 2008.

'Exit Strategy' is the first book in a new series by Kelley Armstrong.

An assassin hitting targets 'just because' is always bad for business. To preserve their interests, five assassins will track him down and stop him. Nadia Stafford is invited by her mentor to join this hunt; an ex-cop turned assassin, her chosen targets are those whose departures will only benefit society.

The plot flows well and follows the pace of the hunt; slow in the beginning and faster towards the end as they identify the Helter Skelter killer and set their trap.

If you like Jeffrey Archer's 'Honour Among Thieves', then this may interest you as it has similar themes running through it.






Safety Razor Set

Poe: A Life Cut Short

Edgar Allan Poe served as a soldier and began his literary career composing verses modelled on Byron; soon he was trying out his 'prose-tales' - often horror melodramas such as *The Fall of the House of Usher*. As editor of the *Literary Messenger* he was influential among critics and writers of the American South. His versatile writings - including, for example, *The Murders in the Rue Morgue* and *The Raven* - continue to resonate down the centuries.

Peter Ackroyd's biography of Poe opens with his end, his final days - no one knows what happened between the time when friends saw him off on the steam-boat to Baltimore and his discovery six days later dying in a tavern. This mystery sets the scene for a short life packed with drama and tragedy (drink and poverty) combined with extraordinary brilliance.

Poe has been claimed as the forerunner of modern fantasy, and credited with the invention of psychological dramas (long before Freud), science fiction (before H.G. Wells and Jules Verne) and the detective story (before Arthur Conan Doyle). Tennyson described him as 'the most original genius that America has produced'. He influenced European romanticism and was the harbinger of both Symbolism and Surrealism. Peter Ackroyd, who places significance on Poe's childhood (his travelling actor parents were miserably poor, his mother had TB and he was orphaned), claims that Poe found his family among writers - writers not only of his time but of the future generations who were influenced by the power of his imagination. **HC \$39.95**

The Forgotten ANZACs

Every school child in Australia and New Zealand is brought up on the legend of the Anzacs. This, though, is the largely unknown story of another Anzac force which fought not at Gallipoli, but in Greece a generation later.

On 12 April 1941, General Thomas Blamey, commander of the Australian Imperial Force in the Mediterranean, issued an order of the day announcing the formation of a new Anzac Corps. Australian and New Zealand troops were at the time fighting side by side in Greece against an invading German army that had been triumphant everywhere. With the very existence of his force in the balance, Blamey invoked the spirit of Gallipoli to inspire his troops, suggesting: the reunion of the Australian and New Zealand Division gives all ranks the greatest uplift. The task ahead though difficult is not nearly so desperate as that which our fathers faced in April twenty-six years ago. We go to it together with stout hearts and certainty of success.

Those hopes would be quickly dashed. Desperately outnumbered, and fighting in deeply inhospitable conditions, the Anzacs found themselves engaging in a long retreat through Greece, under constant air attack. Most of the Anzac Corps was evacuated by the end of April, but many men got only as far as Crete. Fighting a German paratroop invasion there in May, large numbers were taken captive and spent four long years as prisoners of the Nazis.

The campaign in Greece turned out to have uncanny parallels to the original Gallipoli operation: both were inspired by Winston Churchill, both were badly planned by British military leaders, and both ended in defeat and evacuation. British bungling at Gallipoli was one thing; but in Greece, Churchill authorised his commanders to leave the Anzacs to their fate if their rescue compromised wider British interests.

Just as Gallipoli provided military academies the world over with lessons in how not to conduct a complex feat of arms, Churchill's Greek adventure reinforced fundamental lessons in modern warfare - heavy tanks could not be stopped by men armed with rifles, and Stuka dive-bombers would not be deflected by promises of air support from London that were never honoured.

Until now, there has been no history on the campaign in Greece and Crete written from a truly Anzac perspective. Based on rarely accessed archives and more than 30 interviews with Australian, Greek, and New Zealand veterans, this superb book gives overdue recognition to the brave, forgotten Anzacs of 1941. **HC \$59.95**

But if there's one rule at Prairie Bluff, it's never meddle in the lives of the Heroines, however cruel the destinies to which they are bound. There's nothing to be done for poor Emma, immersed in her narrative crisis, save for the provision of tea, a tirelessly sympathetic ear, and clean linens.

Adolescent angst isn't a patch on beautiful and grief-stricken- and Penny, a moody thirteen, knows she's no competition for her mother's attentions against these ethereal creatures. Hurt and excluded, and frustrated by her mother's passivity in the face of Emma's terrible fate, Penny strikes out across the Prairie to cool her hot head.
