The Children of Men by P D James, reviewed by Garry Dalrymple

Rather confronting to read this book at the time, I was reading it before and after the sit down meeting to discuss the future roles of the Futurian Society of Sydney (est. 1939) and the Friday night Sydney Futurian discussion meeting. Imagine a world where no (book) SF fan had been born for 25 years?

This book by 'Queen of Crime Writing' P.D. James is/was her only SF book and it was published only after her death. The idea of posthumous publication of genre novels as a courtesy to readers is one with much to recommend to the authors of long-winded Quest Fantasy series. My main impression in reading the book is 'Why'? So much in the book, that is important to the story is poorly explained. It doesn't help that the theme of the book is dated, the pessimistic 1960s / 1970s view of a human civilisation done in by Pollution / War or some other runaway catastrophe; a reduced humanity facing an inevitable extinction of the species; the same fate that humanity has been carelessly meting out to other lesser species. At the time it was written it might have been ground breaking in a minor sort of a way, as the ZPG is not mandated by government, it happens in spite of official intentions. So the story starts off with an immediate large debt to George Orwell's 1984, with a main character recounting recent history through his diary. Using this stratagem, the main character then lays out the basics of the world in which this story is set. A world in a slow freefall towards race extinction, as no



child has been born on Earth for 25 years, all men and stored sperm are (apparently) infertile and all hope of any change to this has pretty much died out. A world that must end with a diminishing and dying circle of 90 year olds who will be left to care for themselves. I was quite impressed by the economy of the setup first chapter. It demonstrates P. D. James' considerable skill of description, getting the 'crime scene' right before moving on with the story. If only Margaret Atwood had this sort of skill, 'The Handmaid's Tale' could have been 200 pages shorter? After this we have an encounter with 'Julian', AKA Winston Smith's Julia, the main character is contacted because he is the cousin of the Dictator of Great Britain. Julia(n) is part of the 'Fishes' an underground resistance cell with five members and apparently it is the only resistance cell in all of England! The Main character passes the Fishes demands on to the Dictator and not many changes. Subsequently, he is again contacted by the Fishes after one member is caught by the Secret Police, they hope that he can intercede with the Dictator to save them from a death squad, oh and Julia(n) is Pregnant, no cause or explanation is given, other than that the bureaucracy may have slipped up on their intrusive regime of monitoring of the potentially still fertile. Astonishingly convenient that this should just happen to Julia(n), giving the Resistance an important card to play? What follows then is a cross country chase, will the baby be born 'free' or as a possession of the Dictator? The implication that there might be more births out there is neglected. Conclusions – Considering this book as a Science Fiction Story it has a number of glaring faults, faults that are characteristic of a Non-SF writer trying their hand at genre Fiction. Firstly, important things are left explained i.e. we are given no logical or quasi-logical explanation for the central fact of the book; a worldwide and universal baby drought just happens, Virus, Comet, Pollution or act of a vengeful God? It is just offered without further explanation. Secondly, not just the cause of the baby drought is left unexplained; the writer would have us believe that the governments and institutions of the World just didn't notice or were incurious about this developing trend! Thirdly, and the most jarring, after completing this book I realized that the writer has an adventure set in 2020 where the technology available is stuck in the 1960s! I'm afraid I have to give the book a B minus

American Gods by Neil Gaiman reviewed by Len Newland



A man is released from prison two days early to attend his wife's funeral. He promptly runs into a couple of gods and a resurrected corpse. This opening develops into a war between a multitude of gods. One story question is why both sides are so interested in this man and what he has to do with the war.

To me, the book read as author Gaiman's attempt at the Great American Novel, as such interesting mainly to American readers. Only after I'd finished did I discover that Gaiman is English, so the novel is actually an outsider's view of the American mind. My copy of the book is a tenth anniversary edition (2011), which speaks of the novel's popularity, but I don't know where the original edition sold.

Gaiman says he visited the locations mentioned, writing the novel as he went; in places, the novel reads that way, although the story outline is consistent. The novel explores what it means to be American in respect of ancient gods, tending in spots to straight essay. The gods (including an American buffalo god, and African and Asian gods, but focussed on European gods) find it hard to survive in America due to American materialism. Through most of the novel, they appear to have relocated entirely to America (clarified only in a final Postscript), which tended to disconnect me as a non-American reader from the story situation, as I also felt disconnected from the character, who acts with little emotive compulsion. Background detail seems to dominate other story aspects, which for me slowed the reading. Most of the first fifteen chapters (of twenty) end away from the main character's point of view, these diversions being only sometimes related to the story line, while for the final chapters Gaiman found it necessary to switch to omniscient multiple POV mode; I would have been happier without this switch. Apart from English tending to average at times, I also found the reading slowed by pedantic action detail, such as the character going up the stairs, opening the door, closing it behind him, etcetera, when all he does is go upstairs to the room.

I did think the meaning of the war of the gods given near the end was a good story twist, as was the meaning of the main character. After the war is settled, all loose ends are carefully tied up except one (why the wife put the character in jail in the first place), but maybe I missed it. Overall, and without knowing who bought the original edition, I see this novel as a reasonable depiction of the American mind told in a reasonable story; I did, however, find myself reading it in small chunks over a long period.
